SUBJECT: Request for 30 day extension regarding the Westinghouse response to Notice of Violation, EA 93-075, dated March 16, 1994

Westinghouse is in receipt of your letter of March 16, 1994 (Notice of Violation, EA 93-075, Docket No. 99900404) wherein you concluded that certain of our activities did not fulfill Part 21 responsibilities. Though you also concluded that this situation has been corrected, you requested that Westinghouse provide a response detailing what actions we have taken or intend to take to ensure that information provided to the NRC is complete and accurate in all material respects. Our response was requested within 30 days of the date of your letter.

Westinghouse is currently addressing your request. We find that to properly respond we will need in excess of the original 30 day limit and do herein request a 30 day extension. We have previously discussed our request for a 30 day extension with Mr. Joseph J. Petrosino of the NRC Vendor Inspection Branch.
