Dear Mr. Moore:

We hereby request that an import license be issued to IRT Corporation, P.O. Box 80817, San Diego, California 92138, to allow the importation of low enriched uranium dioxide pellets from Japan. This shipment originates from Nuclear Fuel Industries (NFI) in Tokai, Japan.

The destination of these pellets is IRT Corporation at the above address in San Diego. Their ultimate use is for the performance testing of a fuel rod scanner that will be delivered to NFI by IRT. This work will be performed under IRT license SNM 1405. The total pellet weight is 26 kg and the maximum enrichment of any pellet is less than 4 percent.

The material is packaged for shipment according to DOT requirements and uses a DOT Spec 6M container.

We request that the normal waiting period for issuance of the license be waived because of an urgent need to have this material by Monday, October 4, for testing scheduled to begin on that date.
