Subject: Shift Technical Advisor Training Program

Re: Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2

By letter dated September 14, 1982, you proposed certain interim changes to the shift technical advisor (STA) training program for your facility. The STA training program had been previously described in your letter dated December 31, 1980 and approved by our letter dated January 18, 1982. The interim changes would permit personnel that have not been fully trained per your approved program to serve as STAs until April 1983. This substitution of personnel would make it possible to upgrade the training of your permanent STAs by providing them an opportunity to train for and obtain senior reactor operator (SRO) licenses.

We feel that including SRO licensing in your STA training requirements will significantly strengthen your STA program, and, thus, we support it. Further, we have reviewed your proposed interim changes and find them acceptable for a limited period of time ending April 1983.
