Dear Mr. Chairman:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is amending its regulations in 10 CFR 50.54(bb) to clarify the timing of notification of spent fuel management and funding plans by the Commission's licensees of those nuclear power reactors that have been shut down prematurely. The final rule requires that a licensee submit such notification either within 2 years after permanently ceasing operation of its licensed power reactor or no later than 5 years before the reactor operating license expires, whichever event occurs first.
