The attached change package is being provided for your review and approval as requested by Mr. L. Phillips of your staff, most recently at the October 28, 1993 meeting. The package consists of the changes to Revision 4 of the Emergency Procedure Guidelines (EPGs) to enhance operator response concerning ATWS/Stability. These changes have been reviewed and approved by the BWROG Emergency Procedure Committee and members of the BWROG Stability Committee. General Electric has completed design reviews of the change package.

As discussed with members of your staff, it is our desire that you will perform a review of the change package and provide approval, possibly as an addendum to the Safety Evaluation Report issued for Revision 4 of the Ei Gs. While this information has already been made available to member utilities, it is our intent to submit the change package to the utilities along with the NRC approval for implementation via letter from the BWROG Executive Chairman when NRC approval is obtained.
