SEQUOYAH FUELS CORPORATION'S NOTICE OF APPEAL OF LBP-94-5 AND LBP-94-8

Pursuant to 10 CFR §§ 2.714a(a) and (c), Sequoyah Fuels Corporation ("SFC") hereby files its Notice of Appeal of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's ("Licensing Board") rulings in the Memorandum and Order (Granting Intervention Motion; Referring Ruling to the Commission) dated February 24, 1994 ("LBP-94-5") and the Memorandum and Order (Supplemental Petition to Intervene) dated March 22, 1994 ("LBP-94-8").¹⁷

In LBP-94-5, the Licensing Board granted Native Americans for a Clean Environment ("NACE") standing to intervene in this enforcement proceeding. In LBP-94-8, the Licensing Board admitted the two contentions proffered by NACE in its February 8, 1994 supplemental intervention petition. LBP-94-8 therefore constitutes the Licensing Board's final ruling on NACE's petition and triggers SFC's right of appeal under 10 CFR §§ 2.714a(a) and (c).

¹ LBP-94-8 was served upon SFC by regular mail on March 23, 1994.

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SFC appeals the Licensing Board's rulings in LBP-94-5 and LBP-94-8 because the NACE petition should have been wholly denied.^{2/} In support of this Notice of Appeal, SFC is concurrently submitting its "Brief On Appeal of LBP-94-5 and LBP-94-8."
