Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. 2.772, the Petition of Plains Electric Generation and Transmission Cooperative, Inc. for Leave to Intervene; Request for Finding of Significant Change and for Antitrust Hearing; and Preliminary Comments on Antitrust Issues, dated April 1, 1994, is hereby referred to the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation for consideration in determining whether to make a finding that significant changes have occurred within the meaning of Section 105c of the Atomic Energy Act.
