This is to confirm our telephone conversation of yesterday, concerning the "Request for Hearing and Answer of Hartsell D. Phillips," which you filed on March 30, 1994, in response to the "Order Prohibiting Involvement in NRC-Licensed Activities (Effective Immediately)" of March 10, 1994, 59 Fed. Reg. 13346.

In our conversation, I noted that your filing does not specifically include a motion to set aside the immediate effectiveness of the Order. You confirmed that you do not now seek this relief and you understand that you may be barred from doing so later under NRC procedures. Based on our conversation, I indicated that the Staff would not file a response to your filing within five days of its receipt, as we would have been required to do if you had sought this relief.
