Dear Mr. Roony.

With reference to your letter of October 11, 1990, concerning the application for license number WSNM 025669 I am pleased to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Korea confirms the following particulars for the international transfer of nuclear material :

- (a) The transfer of the amount of 21,131Kg Uranium Hexafiuoride(UF6) will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Cooperation, which entered into force on March 19,1978, as amended, concerning the civil uses of atomic energy between the Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of the United States;
- (b) The Korea Fuel Co., Ltd. as an intermediate consignee and the Korea Electric Power Corporation, the ultimate consignee, as identified on the application, are authorized by the Government of the Republic of Korea to receive and possess the nuclear material.

However, as to your letter of September 19, 1990, regarding the application for license number XSNM 02563, a final decision has not been reached at this time. The matter is now under consideration and we will inform you of our decision when it is made.
