SUBJECT: Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2 Docket Nos. 50-416 and 50-417 License No. NPF-13 File: 0260/L-814.2 SQRT Qualification of Thermocouples Affected by Variable Pool Swell Loads -SSER 3, Section 3.10 AECM-82/477

The qualification testing of thermocouples discussed in SSER 3, Section 3.10 has been completed, and Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) has obtained copies of the Test Response Spectra (TRS), in advance of the publication of the final test report. A comparison of the TRS to the Required Response Spectra (RRS), which includes the effect of variable pool swell loads, shows that the TRS envelopes the RRS in both the horizontal and vertical directions for the faulted condition.

Therefore, MP&L considers the thermocouples listed in AECM-82/314 (including 1M71-TE-N025A, B, C, D which were inadvertently omitted) to be qualified for seismic and hydrodynamic loads, including variable pool swell. Additionally, MP&L feels that this correspondence closes the thermocouple issue in SSER 3, Section 3.10.

When the final test report is received from the vendor, it will be review in accordance with MP&L's SQRT program procedures. The results of the review will be documented and filed, accordingly.
