
Gentlemen:

In a letter dated June 13, 1990, (ØCANØ69Ø11), Arkansas Nuclear One committed to implementing a program to control and maintain Regulatory Guide 1.97 instrument identification on control panels by November 15, 1990.

However, due to the current ANO-1 refueling outage, detailed review of the procedure which will implement this program has been delayed. It is now expected that the procedure review will be completed and the program will be implemented by January 31, 1991. This revision has been discussed with members of NRC Region IV staff.
