Gentlemen:

Enclosed for your consideration is a copy of a September 22, 1982, letter from Mr. P. J. Breheny, FEMA VII Regional Director to Mr. J. G. Keppler, Regional Administrator NRC. Please note the concerns expressed by FEMA Region VII regarding late submittals of exercise scenarios and failure to adhere to FEMA Guidance Memorandum No. 17. The Region III staff recognizes the adverse impact on overall emergency preparedness that would occur if FEMA Region VII did not participate in future Quad-Cities exercises. The staff is confident, however, that close adherence to the submittal schedule provided in Memorandum No. 17 will improve scenario quality and will ultimately result in the attainment of a demonstrated adequate state of onsite and offsite emergency preparedness.

Therefore, to further impress upon Commonwealth Edison Company the importance both NRC and FEMA place on timely scenario submittal, be advised that if FEMA does not observe an exercise, it is likely that offsite authorities will not participate during your exercise. Accordingly, the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section F may not be met.
