SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 90-03 FOR THE CALLAWAY NUCLEAR PLANT
(TAC NO. 76217/ULNRC-2294)

On March 20, 1990, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 90-03, "Relaxation of Staff Position in Generic Letter 83-28, Item 2.2 Part 2 'Vendor Interface for Safety-Related Components'." The GL requested that all licensees and applicants review their present vendor interface programs and modify them as necessary using the guidance supplied in the GL.

By letter dated September 21, 1990, you responded to GL 90-03 indicating that a proceduralized program for periodic contact with selected vendors of safety-related components will be implemented by December 31, 1990. Additionally, you indicated that you would maintain your previous commitment to maintain a list of applicable vendors as described in letters dated November 18, 1983 and May 17, 1985. The staff has reviewed your response, noting your commitment to maintain full compliance with the intent of Generic Letter 90-03, and finds it acceptable.

This action closes TAC No. 76217. Please inform the staff, in writing, within 30 days of implementation of your commitments with regard to this GL.
