RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT TO SOURCE MATERIAL LICENSE SUA-1403 FOR CENTRAL ELECTRIC GENERATING BOARD EXPLORATION (AMERICA)

INC. (C.E.G.B.) - LEUENPERGER SITE

The NRC received a request from C.E.G.B. by letter dated November 8, 1990, to renew Source Material License SUA-1403 for the Leuenberger site located in Converse County, Wyoming. The NRC has previously issued a license to C.E.G.B. with the condition that site operations regulated therein may not commence until such time as License Condition Nos. 19, 23, 26, and 46 are met.

Renewal of Source Material License SUA-1403 calls for amendment to License Condition Nos. 1, 2, 4, 14, and 15 to reflect the change in licensee address, license expiration date, and a change in the staff position title from Radiation Protection Officer (RPO) to Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). The NRC will also take this opportunity to change the USNRC designation in the license to NRC in accordance with agency policies.

Therefore, pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40, and in accordance with the licensee submittal dated November 8, 1990, Source Material License SUA-1403 is amended by revising License Condition Nos. 1, 2, 4, 14 and 15 to read as follows:

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- 14. In additio, to inspections and audits as specified in Section 5.0 of the application and Section XXIV of the Health Physics Manual, the RSO shall perform and document a daily "walk through" inspection of the open ting area to determine if written procedures and policies are being followed. On a monthly basis, the RSO shall prepare a summary report of the daily and weekly inspections, personnel exposures, environmental monitoring data and corrective actions which shall be submitted to the Manager.
- 15. The RSG or other expert with equivalent qualifications shall conduct and document an annual ALARA audit of the radiation safety program at the facility and submit a written report with any necessary corrective actions to the Manager. A copy of the audit report shall be submitted to the NRC, Uranium Recovery Field Office, within one (1) month of the submittal to the Manager.

All other conditions of the license will remain the same. The license is being reissued to incorporate the changes described above.
