



Dear Representative Klink,

Recent power shortages make it clear that Congress goofed in designing the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The N.R.C. was not designed to promote safety in the nuclear industry; it was designed to prevent nuclear power from becoming "too cheap to meter". To achieve this objective, the N.R.C. has been obliged to lie to the people about the hazards of nuclear power. The N.R.C.'s largest lie is its regulation which says that nuclear power plant accidents can cause prompt deaths ten miles from the plant. Such lies caused the cancelation of construction of over one hundred nuclear power plants. We could have used those plants during the floods and hurricanes of last year, and during the recent cold wave. See enclosure. Some plan for that "rainy day"; others do not.

Congress could correct its error by passing a resolution declaring: "it is the sense of Congress that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission shall promote safety in the nuclear industry".
