Dear Mr. Stolz:

This letter identifies a proposed schedule for responding to the information requested in reference (1) regarding NUREG-0737, Item II.B.3, Post Accident Sampling System. The August 24, 1982 letter provided additional detailed design and operating criteria for the sampling system and analytical equipment used for post accident analysis of the reactor coolant and containment atmosphere.


Currently, we are working with the BWR Owner's Group to address those items that are generic to the post-accident sampling system developed by General Electric for BWR plants.

Completion of this task is expected in December of this year. An additional month will be required to develop a plant specific response. Therefore, we propose a January 31, 1983 submittal date for responding to Item II.B.3 of NUREG-0737.
