Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10 CFR 55.25, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) has removed a licensed individual (Docket Number 55-21156) from licensed duties at the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant. This action was taken as a result of a fitness for duty concern. At approximately 1900 on November 6, 1990, while at home, the individual requested assistance after ingesting an overdose of prescription drugs. There were no long-term physical effects as a result of the incident and the individual is currently physically fit. The individual is no longer authorized for unescorted access and will remain in a non-licensed staff position pending resolution of the event by CP&L. This event was reported in accordance with 10 CFR 26.73(2)(1).
