Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. T. L. Simmons of this office on October 26, 1990 of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 48-15342-02 and to the discussion of our findings with you, Dr. E. Wallen and Mr. Z. R. Korszun at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated December 19, 1988 regarding apparent violations found during our November 2 and 4, 1988, inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed notice. A written response is required.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
