Gentlemen:

River Bend Station (RBS) has reviewed commitments made regarding natural resource management at the River Bend site. These commitments included site restoration after construction and land and wildlife management. As part of the land and wildlife management RBS committed to construct a lake (TAC 83577). The lake would be built to enhance wildlife management generally consistent with the description provided in the Environmental Report and the Final Environmental Statement. However, wildlife in the area may have adequately adapted to the existing environment making any disturbances unwarranted. If an evaluation determines that the land and wildlife are best left undisturbed, RBS will not construct the lake. Otherwise, construction of the lake will be pursued by RBS.
