AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 73 License No. DPR-3

- 1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The filing* by Yankee Atomic Electric Company (the licensee) dated June 10, 1981, as supplemented December 8, 1981, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the filing, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied:
- 2. Accordingly, Facility Operating License No. DPR-3 is hereby amended by reformating and renumbering Paragraphs 2.C.(3), Security Plan** and 2.C.(6), Contingency Plan***, as 2.C(3)a and b respectively, and adding a new paragraph 2.C.(3)c for the Guard Training and Qualification Plan to read as follows:

2.C(3) Physical Protection

- a. The licensee shall maintain in effect and fully implement all provisions of the Commission-approved physical security plan, including amendments and changes made pursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54(p). The approved security plan consists of 10 CFR 2.790(d) information, titled, "Modified Amended Security Plan for Yankee Atomic Electric Company," dated November 29, 1978. (Originally approved by License Amendment No. 55, February 23, 1979).
- The licensee shall fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the Commission-approved Safeguards Contingency Plan, including amendments and changes made pursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54. The approved Contingency Plan consists of documents withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d) identified as Chapter 8 (revisions 4 and 5) of the "Modified Amended Security Plan for Yankee Atomic Electric . Company" as revised April 10, 1980 and June 16, 1980, submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 73.40. The Plan shall be fully implemented in accordance with 10 CFR 73.40(b), within 30 days of this approval by the Commission. (Originally approved by License Amendment No. 63, January 23, 1981).
- c. The licensee shall follow all provisions of the Commission . approved Guard Training and Qualification Plan, including amendments and changes made pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p). The approved Guard Training and Qualification Plan identified as "Yankee-Rowe Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan," dated June 10, 1981, as revised by pages dated December 8, 1981 and consists of documents containing Safeguards Information which are being protected from unauthorized disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21. The Guard Training and Qualification Plan shall be fully implemented in accordance with 10 CFR 73.55(b)(4) within 60 days of this approval by the Commission.
- 3. This license amendment is effective as of its date of issuance.

Revision to First Paragraph of Section 2.2

2.2 Training

The training program and critical security tasks and duties for the security organization personnel is defined in the Yankee Rowe Atomic Power Station Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan which meets the requirements of 10 CFR Part 73, Appendix B for the training, equipping and requalification of the security organization members. The training program provides a commitment to preclude the assignment of any member of the security organization to a duty prior to his being trained, equipped and qualified to perform the assigned duty in accordance with the approved guard training and qualification plan.
