Gentlemen:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission recently received an allegation (AMS No. RIII-90-A-0107) concerning alleged inappropriate management practices on the part of one of your contractors relating to a personnel issue. The individual indicated he felt wronged because a written notice of admonishment was placed in his personnel file as a result of an alleged incident that was not duty related. After a review of the alleged's correspondence we concluded that there are no safety concerns stated and there is no regulatory basis for further action on our part. We are providing details of this allegation to you for your information only. No response is required, however, should you review this information and determine that the allegation is substantiated and has regulatory or safety significance, please notify the Region of this information.

The alleged claims that your contract security force management has mishandled his case because a letter of reprimand has not been removed from his file. Although he explicitly states this issue will not deter him from performing his security duties, he does feel frustrated. Details are included in the attached enclosure. He indicates that the site Security Supervisor is knowledgeable of this issue as a result of their discussion.

We request that your response if necessary contain no personal privacy, proprietary, or safeguards information so it can be released to the public and placed in the NRC Public Document Room. If necessary, such information shall be contained in a separate attachment which will be withheld from public disclosure.

The enclosure to this letter should be controlled and distribution limited to personnel with a "need to know" until your investigation of the allegation has been completed. The enclosure to this letter is considered Exempt from Public Disclosure in accordance with Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 2.790(a). Moreover, a copy of this letter, excluding the enclosure, will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
