SUBJECT: ISSUANCE OF EXEMPTION TO 10 CFR 50.47 and PART 50, APPENDIX E,
FOR THE RANCHO SECO NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION (TAC NO. 77229)

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has granted the enclosed exemptions
for the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station regarding:

- ° Conduct of a biennial offsite full participation emergency preparedness exercise, including any testing of the siren system.
- ° Dissemination of public information.

The exemptions are granted in response to your letter of July 24, 1990.

We find that granting the exemptions is authorized by law, will not present an undue risk to the public health and safety, is consistent with the common defense and security, and meets the special circumstances described in 10 CFR 50.12 (a)(2)(ii), (iii), and (vi).

The Exemption has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
