Subject: PROPOSED IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTY - $\$ 12,500$
This is to inform the Commission that a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty in the amount of $\$ 12,500 \mathrm{w} 111$ be issued on or about December 5, 1990 to Baltimore Gas and Electric Company. This action is based on a security shift supervisor suspending metal detector searches because of malfunctioning equipment and allowing employees to enter the protected area during a 15 minute period without either pat-down or hand held metal detector searches. At least four other security officers on duty at the time, who should have known the supervisor made an improper decision, did not take action to prevent, correct, or even report this obvious violation, while the penalty was escalated 25\% for corrective action, this was offset by 100\% mitigation for good past performance in the area of security.

It should be noted thet the licensee has not been specifically informed of the enforcement action. The schedule of issuance and notification is:
