On June 30, 1982, Florida Power and Light Co. (FPL) notified Region II Office of Inspection and Enforcement, in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.55(e) of a potential deficiency regarding the failure of reactor shutdown cooling bypass valves to respond to command signals. FPL is still reviewing this problem and will submit a final report by October 30, 1982.
