By Reference 1 you requested confirmation dates of certain Post-TMI Requirements. Reference 2 provided the information you requested. This letter is to update the status of the subject items.

Due to continuing vendor delays, the District has cancelled its original contract and has selected a new vendor. The District will complete installation and confirm operability of the new system by the completion of the Spring, 1983, outage, which is scheduled to begin in April, 1983. Compensatory sampling measures which were discussed in Reference 3 have been implemented and are considered adequate in the interim.
