
AFFIDAVIT OF ELLYN R. WEISS

I, Ellyn R. Weiss, having been sworn, state as follows:


1. I am an attorney in the law firm, Harmon & Weiss, 1725 I Street, N.W., Suite 506, Washington, D.C. 20006.
2. I am General Counsel of the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS), and served as counsel for UCS at the NRC Atomic Safety and Licensing Board proceeding on the restart of Three Mile Island Unit 1 (TMI-1), Docket No. 50-289 (Restart).
3. Throughout Licensing Board proceedings in the TMI-1 Restart hearing in November and December, 1980 and January, 1981, the Licensing Board allowed UCS scientist Robert Pollard to act as both expert witness on behalf of UCS and as cross-examiner of the witnesses of other parties to the proceeding.
