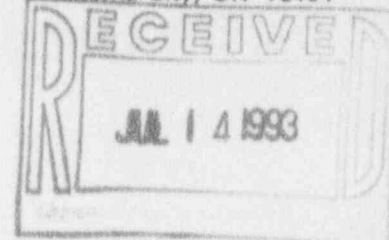
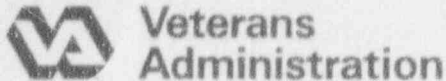


Dear Mr. Whitten:

To expedite the processing of our license renewal application, we have added the statements of our willingness to accept your rulings where we are requesting deviations from the normal procedures.

We would also like to take this opportunity to inform you of the following change in the administration by the Radiation Safety Committee. Recently, the Committee has come to the decision that efficiency will be improved by changing the frequency of renewal of internal authorization from annually to biennially. (This means that item 10.2.1C on page 13 of our revised license application now reads "Biennial renewal of approved user minilicenses with appropriate amendments and changes".)
