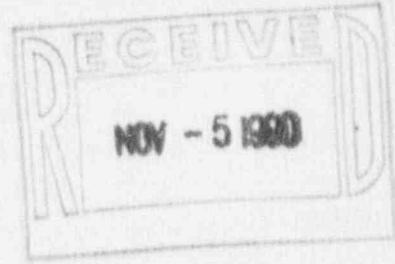

Gentlemen:

In our response to Weakness 313/9008-11; 368/9008-11 for the subject Inspection Report, we stated that an automated-computer based emergency notification system would be implemented by January 1, 1991. Recognizing that the purpose of this system is to improve the speed and efficiency with which the Emergency Response Organization is notified in the event of an actual emergency, this proposed revision to the installation schedule will not impact our original intent to install the system, train personnel, and evaluate its effectiveness through a number of small scale drills.

Therefore, to allow for these additional activities and allocation of the appropriate funds, we have determined that the use of this notification system will not be implemented until March 29, 1991. However, this schedule change will still enable us to further evaluate the system's capability under simulated severe accident conditions during the 1991 exercise, which is scheduled for May 1991. This change was discussed with Mr. Nemen Terc of your staff on October 31, 1990.
