Dear Sirs:

This is to request an exemption from the requirements of regulations in 10 CFR Parts 170 and 171 for Indiana University School of Medicine, Evansville Center for Medical Education (license # 13-15734-01).

The Evansville Center for Medical Education is a branch campus of the Indiana University School of Medicine in Indianapolis, IN. As such, its student population is a total of 32, its faculty who use radionuclides in research number 8, and the total number of full-time employees is less than 25. For this reason, the assessment of the annual fee will result in a significantly disproportionate allocation of costs to the licensee.

The Evansville Center for Medical Education is supported by funds allocated to it through the Indiana University School of Medicine. Payment of the fee would detract from the educational mission of the institution by taking monies budgeted for educational programs. Furthermore, the amount of the fee is a significant proportion of operating funds and, thus, will become a financial burden to this branch of the institution.

Therefore, we request an exemption from the annual fee because such an assessment would not be a fair and equitable allocation of the NRC costs. If I can supply any further information for your consideration, please do hesitate to notify me.
