Gentlemen:

In regard to your letter of August 3, 1982, you should be aware that Woodward Governor Company was cited for their failure to adopt appropriate procedures with respect to Section 21.21(a) of 10 CFR Part 21 and also their failure to post in accordance with the requirements of Section 21.6 of 10 CFR Part 21. In that their activities on specific contracts which invoked 10 CFR Part 21 as an applicable regulation could be complete, an option was given to the Woodward Governor Company to notify affected customers of their failure to comply with the 10 CFR Part 21 regulation in the manufacture of governors. As a result of this option you have been notified by the Woodward Governor Company.

Accordingly, it is our position that the dedication of governors as a basic component, as defined by 10 CFR Part 21, falls on the procuring party. We would, therefore, expect that full implementation of this regulation would be the direct responsibility of customers of this manufacturer.
