Final disposition of radioactive materials

At the time of termination of our license (August 17, 1993) we had approximately 50 microcuries of carbon-14 as organic liquid waste and 3 microcuries of carbon-14 as aqueous waste. We called Region III to ask how to handle this waste and were advised to incinerate the organic waste and dispose of the aqueous waste in the sink. All other materials that we had purchased during the time that we had our license had long ago decayed in storage.

Results of radiation survey

We calibrated our survey meter following the procedure spelled out in our license application and surveyed the desk tops and floors of the radiation suite (see attached drawing of suite). No evidence of any radiation was detected greater than that of background in any of the region surveyed. License free, sealed sources were removed from the "hot room" during the survey and replaced after the survey was complete.
