At the pre-hearing conference held on October 15, 1982, the Licensing Board chairperson, Judge Helen Hoyt, requested counsel for the Intervenor to submit a proposed protective order. A copy of such a proposed order is attached. Counsel for Intervenor has discussed this matter with Dr. Stillman and believes that the proposed protective order is an appropriate and reasonable way to accommodate his privacy interests. This method will not inconvenience counsel for the Licensee or NRC Staff. The NRC staff has itself recognized the personal and privacy interests individuals have in their addresses and telephone numbers; this type of information is routinely deleted from materials furnished to members of the public by NRC Staff in response to Freedom of Information Act
