Dear Mr. Silberg:

As you know, OCRE is now lead intervenor on Issue #4, and, as I have indicated to you, OCRE will review previous interrogatory responses of intervenors to see if updating of same is necessary. It has come to my attention that OCRE is missing a document pertaining to Issue #4; this must be supplied before any supplementation of responses can occur. Please refer to the June 1, 1982 letter from Robert Willmore to Daniel D. Wilt for details. I have tried without success to obtain the document from Mr. Wilt, who seems unable to locate it. I would appreciate it if you would send me the attachment to the February 3, 1978 letter from Ross and Eisenhut, NRC, to G. Sherwood, GE.

I would also call your attention to what I believe to be a misstatement in "Applicants' Answer to OCRE's Fourth Set of Interrogatories," dated September 28, 1982. Specifically, the answer to interrogatory 4-10 states that Applicants' response to a Staff question has been sent to the service list. OCRE does not receive Applicants' responses to any of the Staff's questions. OCRE did receive them for a short time, upon the request of OCRE's previous representative, Mr. Robert Alexander, but this service has long since been discontinued. The service list does receive Staff's requests for information to Applicants, but the Staff does not send out the responses to same. Therefore, please do not assume that intervenors have timely knowledge of Applicants' responses to Staff's questions. These items are eventually sent to the LPDR (in about 6 weeks), but the LPDR is not always complete or organized properly. I think you should be aware of these facts.
