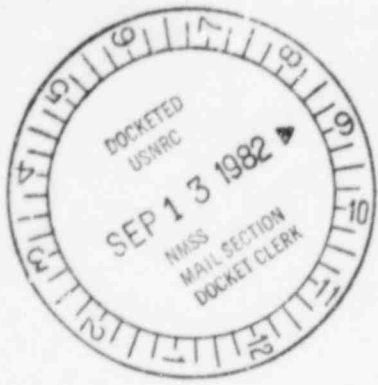

This correspondence transmits the second quarter, 1982 quarterly report sampling and analysis results of the environmental monitoring program as required by license conditions 42, 43 and 47 of Source Material License SUA-917. It also transmits the dose evaluations to the nearest resident based on this actual environmental monitoring data and the dose conversion factors as given in attachment A of "Compliance Determination Procedures for Environmental Radiation Protection Standards for Uranium Recovery Facilities 40 CFR 190".

The Pb²¹⁰ results from the continuous air monitoring stations for the month of June and also for the quarterly ground water samples, have not yet been received from the outside laboratory. These will be forwarded to you under separate cover as soon as we receive them.
