
SUBJECT: Automatic Steam Generator Overfill Protection at Fort Calhoun
Station (FCS)

Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) is submitting this letter to confirm that our response to the NRC regarding implementation of an automatic steam generator overfill protection system at FCS has been extended pending further notification from the NRC.

On November 20, 1990, OPPD met with other members of the Combustion Engineering Owners Group (CEOG) and the NRC staff on the proposed resolution to Generic Letter 89-19. It is OPPD's understanding that the NRC staff present at this meeting concluded that no response to this issue is needed, pending future NRC decisions and directives. Therefore, this letter documents OPPD's withdrawal of our commitment to supply a response to Reference 2 by January 4, 1991.
