Subject: Borough of Maywood, New Jersey

In response to your letter dated September 14, 1982, a NRC Region I inspector performed radiation level measurements and gathered soil samples in and along Coles Brook, Maywood, New Jersey on September 23, 1982. The results of these measurements and analysis of the soil samples can be found in the enclosed Region I Report No. 99990001/82-13.

We conclude that there will be no hazard from radioactive contamination created by the stream clearance project for Coles Brook from the Susquehanna and Western Railroad to Essex Street as described in the attachments to your September 14, 1982 letter.

Some care should be taken, however, to assure that the soil beyond 15 feet from the top of the bank of Coles Brook on the west (Maywood) side from point B south to the edge of the paved parking lot (See Attachment 1 of Report) is not removed from the area. It is not necessary that we conduct any on-site inspection during the clearance project.
