SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC GENERIC LETTER 89-06 ON THE SAFETY PARAMETER
DISPLAY SYSTEM FOR DAVIS-BESSE NUCLEAR POWER STATION, UNIT NO. 1
(MPA F-072, TAC NO. M73650)

In NRC Generic Letter (GL) 89-06, dated April 12, 1989, we requested that you provide certification regarding the implementation of a Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) at your facility. The GL and its attachment, NUREG-1342, provided clarification of the requirements for an acceptable SPDS as originally defined in NUREG-0737, Supplement 1, issued in January 1983.

In your letter dated November 28, 1989, you presented Toledo Edison's schedule for completion of a number of activities currently planned for the Davis-Besse SPDS. In reviewing these activities, we find that you will have met the requirements in NUREG-0737, Supplement 1, for an SPDS upon completion of Item 2 of your planned activities (i.e., perform a human factors review of the SPDS). In this subject letter, you indicated that Item 2 would be completed by December 1, 1990. However, in a telephone conversation with the NRC staff on December 6, 1990, your licensing personnel stated that the completion date for this activity had been revised to March 1991. Accordingly, we request that you submit this revised schedule and that you confirm by letter when your human factors review is completed.

While we conclude that you will meet the staff's requirements for the Davis-Besse SPDS upon completion of Item 2, we encourage you to complete the additional work and upgrades to the SPDS presently scheduled to be completed by February 3, 1992, as indicated in your November 28, 1989 letter. Please contact the NRC Project Manager if you have any questions on this matter.

This request is covered by Office of Management and Budget Clearance Number 3150-0011 which expires January 31, 1991. The estimated average burden hours is 4-person-hours per owner response, including searching data sources, gathering and analyzing the data, and preparing the required letters. These estimated average burden hours pertain only to these identified response-related matters and do not include the time for actual implementation of the requested actions. 



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
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
