Dear Mr. Potter,

I am writing you as chairman of the AS + LBP (EW 439) in regard to the license extension requested by P, E + E for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.

As I am sure you already know, Diablo Canyon is a particularly unsafe Nuclear Power Plant. It is situated 3 miles from the Hosgri Earthquake Fault, + about 35-50 miles from a segment of the San Andreas Fault which has recently been active. It is not safe, and it has never been safe.

In addition to the danger of the plant there is the ever-increasing

• problem of what to do with the
high-level radioactive wastes produced
by nuclear power plants. There is
no safe place to store this stuff
due to the mobility of the earth.
Alternative forms of energy must
be found which do not cause
a continuing threat to people and
the environment.

Please vote against the extension of
the operating license for the Diablo
Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, and take
steps to shut down all such
plants as soon as possible.


