## PREHEARING CONTERENCE ORDER (Issues and Schedules)

This proceeding involves a proposed civil monetary penalty of \$5,000 sought to be levied by the Nuclear Regulatory

Commission (NRC) through an Order issued on January 18, 1994, to the Indiana University School of Medicine (Licensee). 59 Fed.

Reg. 4124 (January 28, 1994). The Licensee holds an NRC byproduct materials license to possess cobalt-60 sealed telepathy sources for medical use and the irradiation of blood and blood products. The Licensee has requested a hearing on the Order, and an Order granting the hearing was issued by the Board on March 11, 1994. See 59 Fe Reg. 12994 (March 18, 1994). A prehearing conference, participated in by representatives of the NRC Staff and the Licensee, was held on April 14, 1994, to discuss the

issues in the proceeding, a schedule proposed by the parties in the case and other matters related to the hearing.

The issues to be considered in the proceeding are the following:

- 1. Whether the Licensee was in violation of the Commission's requirements set forth in the written notice of violation and proposed imposition of civil penalty served on the Licensee on October 7, 1993, and
- Whether, on the basis of such violation, the Order Imposing a Civil Monetary Penalty should be sustained.

The Board approves the following schedule:

The Board will entertain requests for modifying this schedule by telephone conference call with two days advance notice required if the call is to be stenographically recorded.
