NOTICE OF VIOLATION Eli Lilly License No. 13-01133-02 Indianapolis, IN 46285 Docket No. 030-04330 As a result of the inspection conducted on November 13 through 16, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1990) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified: License Condition No. 23 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced applications and letters. The referenced letter dated April 19, 1984, states in item 6 under training of ancillary personnel (e.g., Plant Security, Housekeeping, Animal Caretakers,

etc.) that in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part19, radiation safety education programs are presented by qualified outside speakers and the Radiation Safety Staff on an annual basis for ancillary personnel.

Contrary to the above, training for ancillary personnel has not been performed annually as required. Specifically, training for plant security personnel was not performed in 1988, 1989 or 1990.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
