

Public Service Company of Colorado (PSC) intends to utilize Chem-Nuclear Systems, Inc. (CNSI) shipping cask 1--13G to transport radioactive materials from the Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Generating Station operated under Facility Operating License No. DPR-34, Docket No. 50-267. This shipping package is licensed by CNSI under Certificate of Compliance No. 9044, Revision 7 and Identification No. USA/9044/B()F.

PSC is in possession of a copy of Certificate of Compliance No. 9044, Revision 7, dated December 23, 1980, and all documents and their attachments referenced therein.

PSC commits to comply with the terms and conditions of the subject certificate as well as the applicable regulations which govern the use of this packaging and the shipment of authorized radioactive materials from the Fort St. Vrain facility.
