This is to advise you that the Commission has not objected to the issuance of the Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty in the amount of \$7,500 to P. X. Engineering Co., Inc. The Commission also concurred in the staff's proposal not to take specific enforcement action against the former RSO. (OE)

The Commission understands that the staff has already initiated rulemaking to clarify the requirements of 10 CFR 34.27 so that utilization logs more accurately and effectively document the actual use and users of licensed sources. This rulemaking should proceed without substantial delay. The staff should inform the Commission of the schedule for this rulemaking.
