

Mr. Nellis,

In June of 1993 I addressed a letter to you concerning Grinnell's viewpoint in a mandatory two person crew for field industrial radiography.

Since the recent increase by the NRC in annual licensing fees, the competitiveness of our industry has escalated dramatically. Grinnell Corporation has presented letters to all our current customers, stating that we will operate at all field sites with a mandatory two person crew.

We believe that we are one of the only organizations in New England that has made this commitment regarding a two person crew.
