## SUbject: PROPOSED IMPCSITION OF CIVIL PENALTY - $\$ 50,000$

This is to inforin the Comilissfon that a Notfce of V40 Attan and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty in the amount of $\$ 50,000 \mathrm{will}$ be issued on or about December 17, 1990 to Entergy Opetations, Inc. This action is based on (1) the failure to identify and correct a deficiency with the air-operated Control Room isolation dampers and (2) providing inaccurate information to the NPC in response to Generic Le.ter $88-14$, Instrument Air Supply System Problems Affecting Safety-Related Equipment. These violations were categorized as a single severity Level III probleil. The base civil pendity was escalated 50\% for liRC identification. However, a 50\% mitigation was applied because once put on notice of the problem, the licensee's corrective actions were extensive.

It should be noted that the licensee has not been specifically informed of the enforcement action. The schedule of issuance and notification is:

Malling of Notice December 17, 1990
Telephone Notification of Licensee December 17, 1990
The State of Arkansas will be notified.
The licensee has thirty days from the date of the Notice in which to respond. Following NRC evaluation of the response, the civil penalty may be romitted, mitigated, or imposed by order.

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
