JUNCTION MONOCLINE (SEPTEMBER 21, 1982)

On September 21, 1982, the applicants met with the staff to describe the status of the applicants' investigation of the May Junction monocline. A list of meeting attendees is enclosed. The overall program had been outlined by the applicants during a meeting with the staff on July 21, 1982 (meeting summary dated August 12, 1982). Since July 21, 1982, the applicants had completed a portion of the investigative program described on July 21. The completed investigations consisted of a gravity survey and three rotary borings.

The applicants' position as presented at the meeting was that the recently-acquired field data confirmed their earlier interpretations that the May Junction structure is an unfaulted monoclinal slope. Since, in the applicants' view the May Junction monocline is not fault controlled the applicant concludes that there is no basis for proceeding with further investigations.

On the basis of the information presented, the staff's initial evaluation was that an additional boring(s) would be necessary to provide reasonable assurance that a potentially hazardous geologic structure is not present. The applicants reaffirmed their conclusion and intent to terminate the boring program. The amendment to the PSAR scheduled for late October will include the details of the program already completed as a basis for the applicants conclusion.
