Dear Mr. DeLaBarre:

Enclosed please find letters dated April 6 and April 13, 1994, from Poco Graphite Inc. requesting an amendment to export license XMAT0326 to extend the expiration date by (5) five years.

For the past three amendments, the Trade Development Board of Singapore has provided Import Certificate and Delivery Verifications (ICDV) which are only valid for 24 month periods. Poco Graphite has requested a new ICDV to be valid for a period of 60 months. Poco will forward a copy of the new ICDV as soon as it is received.

Before taking action on this request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the amendment request meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended by the Nuclear Non-proliferation Act of 1978.
