SUBJECT: NRC DECOMMISSIONING INSPECTION - U.C. BERKELEY RESEARCH

REACTOR FACILITY

This letter concerns the July 16-18, 1990, confirmatory radiological survey of the U.C. Berkeley research reactor facility conducted by Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU) under contract to the NRC. This facility was used for activities authorized by NRC license No. R-101.

This inspection was conducted to verify that the conditions of the facility were as described in the "Decommissioning Final Report and Termination Radiation Survey Results" submitted to the Commission on April 16, 1990, and to verify that the residual radioactivity and contamination levels comply with Table I of Regulatory Guide 1.86, and that the exposure limit of 5 microrem/hour above background at one meter had been met. Based on our review of the ORAU's Final Report, ORAU 90/K-53, dated November 1990, the above stated criteria appears to have been met. The enclosed ORAU report is being identified as NRC Inspection Report No. 50-224/90-01.
