its estimate of when the recommendations called for by our
previous order can be provided.

The Chairman, Commissioners Gilinsky and Asselstine have approved the order. Commissioners Ahearne and Roberts have disapproved. Would you please affirm your votes?

MR. CHILK: The second item is an FOIA appeal and before we can take it up, Mr. Chairman, I would need a short notice vote.

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: May I vote to consider this on short notice?

MR. CHILK: It is SECY-82-366, an appeal, Fleischaker regarding the Diablo Canyon Seismic Decision, ALAB-644. It is an appeal for a number of documents related to the consideration of that ALAB.

The Commission with all Commissioners agreeing has approved withholding of all but one document and that document is a document from Mr. Jennings to Commissioner Gilinsky which had been previously given to the ACRS and Commissioner Gilinsky in turn has voted to release it.

(Chorus of unanimous ayes.) MR. CHILK: That completes the affirmation. CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Anything further to come before us at this time? (No response.)
