Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the requirements of 10CFR50.54(f), the NRC issued Generic Letter 89-10, "Safety-Related Motor-Operated Valve Testing and Surveillance," on June 28, 1989.

The generic letter requires that, within 5 years from the date of the generic letter, each addressee with a construction permit should complete all design-basis reviews, analyses, verifications, tests, and inspections that have been instituted in order to comply with items a. through h. of the recommended actions. Supplement 6 to GL 89-10 (March 8, 1994) requested additional information is a licensee intended to extend its current schedular commitment for verifying the capability of the motor-operated valves (MOVs) within the scope of GL 89-10. TU Electric has determined that an extension per Supplement 6 is not necessary since the schedular commitment will be met as described below.

TU Electric will verify the capability of safety-related MOVs to operate under design basis conditions by June 28, 1994. TU Electric will notify the NRC within 30 days of completing actions a. through h. above (by July 28, 1994).

Design Basis calculations have been performed, however final reviews to confirm assumptions and to finalize related design documents will extend beyond June 28, 1994.
