

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Annual Environmental Protection Plan Report

Indian Point Units No. 1, 2, and 3

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (the "NRC") Facility Operating Licenses for Indian Point Units No. 1, 2, (issued April 24, 1981) and 3 (issued May 26, 1981), requires that an annual Environmental Protection Plan Report (the "Report") describing implementation of the facilities' Environmental Protection Plan (the "EPP") for the previous year be submitted to the NRC prior to May 1 of each year. This Report is for the 1993 calendar year.

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B specifies that the Report shall include summaries and analyses of the results of any EPP activities (environmental monitoring) required by Subsection 4.2 of the EPP for the reporting period. Since Subsection 4.2 specifies that no environmental monitoring is required, no summaries or analyses are provided herein.
